



## CREDIT CLASS INFORMATION MEETING Important information (continued):

- \* Incoming 9<sup>th</sup> and higher graders need to turn in permission from their high school with counselor's signature. (except SDUSD)
  - \* PUSD requires students to get counselor's signature before Chinese school starts (or per PUSD school calendar). New School Year starts on 8/31/24.
  - \* Do not wait until summer to get counselor's permission.
- \* Turn in permission to NCCS within first 2 weeks of new school year, to the class teacher.

### Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. Do the 7-8th graders need to submit the counselor signed permission for off-campus permission? (No)
- 2. Will the grade report be mailed to middle school? (No)
- 3. Will the grade report during the Middle School years be transferred to High School and counted as High School Credit? (No. However, the years of study during Middle School Year will be counted.)

### CREDIT CLASS INFORMATION MEETING

### Frequently Asked Questions:

4. If I take two years of Chinese lesson, will it meet High School requirement?

(You need to take at least a year in High School in order to have grade of the third year recorded in High School transcript. Check with your High School counselor for the requirement for graduation. It is recommended that for COLLEGE application, it is better to have three or four (3-4) years of World Language Study.)

### Frequently Asked Questions:

5. What do I do if I miss the class because of sports, other academic competition or events?

(You are allowed to be absent up to 12 hours for any reason per semester. If you will miss more than 12 hours, please fill out a special request and state that the student will self study with assistance of parents or private tutor. There is no make up session to be offered by Chinese school.)
